

CHARM PACK TOTE

By precutting the following pieces and marking them with masking tape or pinned on paper, it will save quite a bit of time in class. If you are unsure of the cutting I will help you in class.

PRE-CUT PIECES

1. LINING FABRIC –

a. CUT 1 - 10" STRIP (WIDTH OF FABRIC). This is most of the bag body lining.

You will need a strip 10" x 47" for the lining of the body of the bag

(a little extra fabric will be needed – see step b)

b. CUT 1 – 14" STRIP (WIDTH OF FABRIC) From this you can get the bottom lining, the bottom reinforcing base cover and a **small 10" x 5" or 6" piece to add to your body lining cut from your 10" strip which is not quite long enough.**

Pieces will be as follows:

1. Bottom lining of bag 11.5" x 16"

2. Bottom reinforcing base cover 19" x 14" (to cover plastic)

LINING FABRIC FOR HANDLES

Cut 2 – 21" X 6" STRIPS IF YOU BUY 1.5" WIDE WEBBING STRAP

OR CUT 2 – 21" X 4" STRIPS IF YOU BUY 1" WEBBING STRAP

LINING FABRIC BINDING-

CUT 1 - 45" X 4" STRIP (you will have to add a few inches to make 45")

2. SOFT AND STABLE - or NEEDLE PUNCH

If using soft and stable, cut one of each. Needle punch is quite thick cut 1 of each, otherwise cut 2 of each if using thin needle punch:

15" x 46" for the body

10" x 15" for the bottom

CHARM SQUARES : 26 – 5" CHARM SQUARES
