

Roll Top Charm Bag Supply List – April 22, 2017

26 – 5 x 5” charm squares or 5 x 5” squares of fabric if you prefer

1 m of coordinating fabric for lining and handles

1 m of Soft & Stable (you can use heavy needle punch for a softer bag)

42” of 1 ½” cotton webbing for handles (1” webbing if you cannot find the 1 ½”)

Matching thread for quilting the bag

505 adhesive spray

One sheet plastic canvas 13.5” x 9” approximately, or flexible cutting board plastic or coroplast, or even heavy cardboard – something stiff for the bottom of the bag. We will cover it with fabric.

Machine in good working order and basic sewing supplies including scissors and pins

Zipper foot and walking foot for your machine

CHARM PACK TOTE

By precutting the following pieces and marking them with masking tape or pinned-on paper, it will save quite a bit of time in class. If you are unsure of cutting I will help.

PRE-CUT PIECES

1. LINING FABRIC

- a) Cut 1 – 10” strip (width of fabric). This is most of the bag body lining.
- b) Cut 1 – 14” strip (width of fabric). From this you can get the bottom lining, the bottom reinforcing base cover and a small 10” x 5” or 6” piece to add to your body lining cut from your 10” strip which is not quite long enough.

Pieces will be as follows:

1. Body lining of the bag 10” x 47” (You will have to join two pieces)
2. Bottom lining of bag 11.5” x 16”
3. Bottom reinforcing base cover 19” x 14” (to cover plastic)

LINING FABRIC FOR HANDLES

Cut 2 – 21” x 6” strips if you buy 1.5” wide webbing strap

OR cut 2 – 21” x 4” strips if you buy 1” webbing strap

LINING FABRIC BINDING

Cut 1 – 45” x 4” strip (you will have to add a few inches to make 45”)

LINING FABRIC HANDLES

Cut 2 – 21” X 6” strips if you buy 1.5” wide webbing strap

OR cut 2 – 21” x 4” strips if you buy 1” webbing strap

LINING FABRIC BINDING

Cut 1 – 45” X 4” strip (you will have to add a few inches to make 45”)

2. NEEDLE PUNCH – or SOFT & STABLE

If using Soft & Stable, cut one of each. If needle punch is quite thick, cut 1 of each, otherwise cut 2 of each if using thin needle punch:

15” x 46” for body

10” x 15” for bottom

CHARM SQUARES: 26 – 5” charm squares, either pre-cuts or squares you cut yourself
