Do you love sewing, cross stitch or embroidery with friends, but can't manage the supplies you need to bring?

The Sew Together Bag is a very useful little bag and ideal for needlework supplies. It has 3 zippered pockets inside, four open pockets, a handy pincushion and a great little needle landing.

All of this is smartly held together by a zipper that forms two handles! Cool!

This awesome sewing supply storage bag will easily store your 8" scissors, a rotary cutter, marking pens, seam ripper, extra needles, floss thread, embroidery snips and much more.

This would be a great gift for friends for special occasions too!

Supplies

- Exterior Fabric: 1 fat quarter (18"x 22") this can be pieced or whole cloth.
 - Lining Fabric: 1/2 yard x WOF (side panels and open pockets) You can mix up the pocket fabrics if desired, *there will be 4 open pocket pieces 8 3/4" x 9 3/4" each.*
 - Pocket Lining: 1/3 yard x WOF
 - Binding Fabric: 1 fat quarter
 - 1/2 yard fusible lightweight interfacing (I used Face it Firm or Pellon Decor Bond. You want something with body)
 - 1 18" x 22" piece of batting or fusible fleece ***if quilting the outside piece***
 - 1 - 18" zipper (can be a metal zipper/separating zipper)
 - 3 - 12" zippers (NOT metal) these zippers will be cut and sewn through.
 - Optional Pincushion - fabric scrap 4" x 6", wool roving or similar stuffing
- Optional Needle Landing - wool felt 3" x 4"
